

# GARDEN PERENNIALS

## Bleeding Heart, White

*Dicentra spectabilis 'Alba'*

Instead of the pink flowers found on the classic old fashioned bleeding heart, this one has completely white flowers. The foliage is a powdery-light green color.

Plant in part to full shade. Plants usually go dormant after flowering but if well watered may last into late summer.

Plant with reach a height of 30" with a 18" spread.
